

Improving Canadian work disability policy to help all people access employment

CRWDP Student Conference and Travel Assistance Awards

We are pleased to offer financial assistance to CRWDP students who are active within the CRWDP network to attend conferences and training opportunities relevant to our transdisciplinary initiative on the future of work disability policy in Canada.

CRWDP students who are currently enrolled at a Canadian university and supervised or mentored by a CRWDP co-investigator are eligible. As well, students must be actively involved in CRWDP cluster activities. Maximum CRWDP conference and travel bursary is \$500. Fund will be made available as reimbursement of incurred expenses upon provision of evidence of payment (e.g., receipts, credit card bill). Successful applicants will be required to write a 250-500 word feature for the CRWDP newsletter about their CRWDP-funded opportunity. The write-up can describe the presentation made at a conference or insights gained through training.
